

What about the 6 surplus Bonus Tiles?

The component list in rulebook states that there are 10 bonus tiles. However, there are actually 16 bonus tiles in the box. 6 of the bonus markers were added to the game twice at short term. You can use all 16 bonus markers.

Can several players perform the same mission in the same round?

Yes, if several players successfully complete the same mission in the same round, the player order determines who successfully completes the mission first and therefore receives more victory points and may score the mission as a media mission. See also "PHASE 7: COMPLETE MISSIONS" in the rulebook.

How does the mission bonus "Pass" works?

Place your Sequence Marker in the top row of the sequence bar to the first free space from the left. This determines your player position for the entire next round, regardless of when you actually pass.

To make it clear that you can still perform actions even though your marker is in the top row, you should turn your marker over to the blank side. When you then actually pass, turn it back to the printed side.

If you use the alternative player markers, you should **lay your rocket on the top bar** during normal passing. If you are using the "Pass" mission bonus, place your **rocket upright on the top bar** instead.

The player order is determined by the combination of the two rows. The players whose player marker is in the top row (from left to right) and who are still allowed to perform actions take their turn first. After that, it is the turn of the players whose player marker is in the bottom row (also from left to right).

Can I play a 6th card with the help of a spy?

One of the agent's actions allows you to take one of your played cards back to your hand. The rule for passing means that you have to pass when you only have one specialist left in your hand. You can therefore play 6x one of your hand cards this way instead of just 5x.

The second sentence in the section "PHASE 1: PERFORM ACTIONS" can easily be misunderstood. It states that each player can play and use up to 5 of their specialist cards. If you take a card back into your hand to play it again, you can play 6x cards from your hand, but you will only play 5 different cards from your hand. Theoretically, you could play a different card than the one you took back and thus actually play all 6 specialist cards. However, this normally makes no sense.

Do I have to say which card I take back into my hand?

You must tell the other players which card you are taking back into your hand with the help of the agent.

Do I have to say which Mission Control cards I am removing?

When you perform a test, you must show your opponents which cards you have drawn and which card or cards you are removing from the game.

Can I look at my removed cards again?

You may look at the cards you have removed from the game at any time. However, you can agree before the start of the game not to allow this. This makes the challenge greater and the game even more exciting.

Can I count the face-down cards of a technology?

You may check the number of Mission Control cards belonging to a technology at any time. You

Why do you need the Alternative Player Markers?

The 8 wooden rockets in player colors replace the round Player Markers for indicating the player order and the announced missions.
